(3) LG&E shall file, within 30 days of the date of this Order, a notice setting forth the name and job title of the LG&E employee who will be responsible for ensuring that: (a) All LG&E crews and resident contractor crews maintain written documentation of their daily job briefings; and (b) LG&E issues a request to all of their mutual assistance crews and off-system contractor crews to maintain written documentation of their daily job briefings.

(4) Upon payment of the \$200.00 civil penalty and filing of the notice, this case shall be closed and removed from the Commission's docket without further Order of the Commission.
