 (1) The charges and credits applied by Jackson Purchase through the FAC for the period from July 17, 2009 through October 31, 2010 are approved.
 (2) Except for its direct-served customer, Jackson Purchase shall transfer (roll-in) 10.749 mills per kWh to base energy rates (as adjusted for line-loss) to reflect the transfer (roll-in) by Big Rivers of 10.212 mills per kWh of fuel costs to Big Rivers' base energy rates that were being recovered through its FAC as approved in Case No. 2010-00495. As there is no line adjustment for direct-served customers, Jackson Purchase shall transfer (roll-in) 10.212 mills per kWh to the base energy rates applicable to its direct-served customer.
 (3) The rates in the Appendix to this Order are approved for service rendered by Jackson Purchase on and after June 1, 2011, the effective date of Big Rivers' change in rates.
 (4) Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Jackson Purchase shall file revised tariff sheets with the Commission setting out the rates approved herein and reflecting that they were approved by this Order.
