T-Mobile shall offer universal supported services to consumers in its service area.</li> <li>3. T-Mobile shall offer these services using its own facilities or a combination of its own facilities and resale of another carrier's services, including the services offered by another ETC.</li> <li>4. T-Mobile shall advertise the availability of and charges for these services using media of general distribution.</li> <li>5. T-Mobile has certified to the Commission that it will comply with the FCC's criteria, in accordance with 47 U.S.C. § 254(e), and is therefore eligible to receive Universal Service Fund support for the current certification period.</li> <li>6.
