Beginning in the second full billing month following the date of this Order, for its Pre-2011 Plans, LG&E shall use an overall rate of return on capital of 7.57 percent, a tax gross-up factor of 0.64, a return-on-equity rate of 10.63 percent, and an overall grossed-up return of 10.85 percent in all future monthly environmental surcharge filings unless directed otherwise by the Commission.
5. Beginning in the second full billing month following the date of this Order, for its 2011 Plan, LG&E shall use an overall rate of return on capital of 7.28 percent, a tax gross-up factor of 0.64, a return-on-equity rate of 10.1 percent, and an overall grossed-up return of 10.4 percent in all future monthly environmental surcharge filings unless directed otherwise by the Commission.
