The proceeds from the promissory note shall be used only for the purposes specified in Butler County's application. 5. Butler County shall obtain approval from the Commission prior to performing any additional construction not expressly authorized by this Order. 6. Notwithstanding ordering paragraphs 4 and 5, if surplus funds remain after the approved construction has been completed, Butler County may use such surplus to construct additional plant facilities if RD approves of the use and the additional construction will not result in a change in Butler County's rates for service. Butler County shall provide written notice of this additional construction in accordance with 807 KAR 5:069, Section 4. 7. Butler County shall file with the Commission documentation of the total costs of this project, including the cost of construction and all
