Sapp's Plumbing is assessed a fine of one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250) for violation of KRS 367.4911 (1)(a) for failure to provide Atmos Energy Corporation, the operator of an underground facility serving the public, with notification of its intended work and work schedule not less than two (2) nor more than ten (10) full working days prior to commencing work. 2. Sapp's Plumbing shall pay one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250) within thirty (30) days of the date of this order by cashier's check or money order payable to the Kentucky State Treasurer and mailed or delivered to the office of the Kentucky Public Service Commission at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602. 3. As a first time violator of the Act, Sapp Plumbing is eligible for mitigation of penalty as established by the Division of Inspection's informal policy and past practice by making a payment of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) and attending a damage prevention training course to be held at the offices of the PSC at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, on December 2, 2019, at 1 p.m. If Greg Sapp on behalf of Sapp Plumbing attends the above training course, the additional one thousand dollars (\$1,000) assessed against him in numerical paragraph one of this order will be vacated.
