agreement and a statement disclosing the amount of the initial

franchise fee. 4. If Kentucky Power is the successful bidder, Kentucky Power shall file with the Commission, within ten days of an increase or decrease in the amount of the initial franchise fee set

forth in the franchise agreement, documentation setting forth the revised fee.
