Valley Gas shall make reasonable efforts to locate any customers due refunds who are no longer Valley Gas customers. Valley Gas shall comply with KRS Chapter 393A regarding unclaimed property. 3. For the reasons set forth above, Valley Gas is assessed a civil penalty of \$25,000, suspended in total, if Valley Gas complies with this Order regarding its obligation to issue refunds and commits no further willful billing violations within five years of service of this Order. 4. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket. 03/04/24 Order Entered: 1. Valley Gas's January 18, 2024 petition for confidential treatment is granted in part and denied in part. 2. The designated material granted confidential treatment by this Order shall not be placed in the public record or made available for public inspection for ten years or until further order of this Commission. 3. If Valley Gas is unable to make such demonstration, the requested material shall be made available for inspection. Otherwise, the Commission shall deny the request for inspection. 6. The Commission shall not make requested material available for inspection for 30 days from service of an Order finding that the material no longer gualifies for confidential treatment in order to allow Valley Gas to seek a remedy afforded by law.
