<p>(b) Service under this schedule is limited to consumers whose load requirements do not exceed 25 kva of transformer capacity. Consumers requiring more than 25 kva shall be served under an appropriate schedule for large power service.</p> <p>(c) Service under this schedule is for uses including lighting, appliances, cooking, heating, and motors, all subject to the established rules and regulations of the cooperative covering this service.</p> <p>(d) Consumers having their homes on the same premises with their business establishments may include service to both on the same meter, in which case all service will be billed under this schedule, using the rate set out above. If the consumer prefers, he may make provisions for two meters, in which case his usage for residential purposes will be billed under the appropriate residential schedule, and his usage for business purposes will be billed under this schedule.</p> <p>(e) The rated capacity of single-phase motors shall not be in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.).</p> <p>(f) Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 H.P.) must be three-phase.</p>
